# CURRENT RESERVOIR AND OUTFLOW OPERATIONS Week of 06/10 through 06/17 WATER YEAR TYPE IS ABOVE NORMAL AT 117% OF NORMAL

#### Aloha Lake:

- Elevation 9.72 = 430 acre feet
- Reservoir still completely iced over with a large amount of snow still around lake.
- Outlet valve opened to full position on 5/17/05 with 42cfs of outflow and 200cfs +- of accretion measured at gage (A-40) Pyramid creek below Horse Tail Falls.
- We plan to start filling reservoir in a couple of weeks.

#### **Echo Lake:**

- Elevation 229 = 725 acre feet
- We have installed three feet of boards in spillway to start filling lake to about 4.50 feet as we get better control of run off we will install remaining boards and fill lake to 6.00 feet.
- Outflow at 10+- cfs.

## Caples Lake:

- Elevation 55.90 = 18,640 acre feet. Reservoir has been increasing 0.50 feet +- for the past few days.
- Some boards are being installed in spillway however we still have about 20% of ice on lake.
- Outflow at 10cfs +- with inflow between 200 and 300cfs for the past few days.

### Silver Lake:

- Elevation 17.00= 5,900 acre feet. Reservoir has been increasing 1.00 feet +- the past few days.
- Radial gates closed and some boards being installed in spillway.
- Outflow at 14.0 cfs. Inflow has been between 200 and 300 cfs for the past week.

**Projected operations:** The lakes will be closely monitored as they now begin to fill. Large amounts of snow remain in the high elevations when "MOTHER NATURE" allows the reservoirs should fill to near capacity level.
