NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO REVISE FACILITY CAPACITY CHARGES TO CORRECT APPLICABLE LINE AND COVER AND GABBRO SOILS SUPPLEMENTAL CHARGES

The El Dorado Irrigation District (District) Board of Directors will convene a Public Hearing on Tuesday, **November 12, 2024, at 9:00 A.M.** to consider corrections to the District's Facility Capacity Charges (FCCs) previously adopted by the Board of Directors on September 23, 2024.

LOCATION: The Public Hearing will be held in the Harry J. Dunlop Customer Service Building at 2890 Mosquito Road, Placerville, California 95667.

DOCUMENT REVIEW AND AVAILABILITY: The Public Hearing is to consider corrections to the Facility Capacity Charges (FCCs) previously adopted by the Board of Directors on September 23, 2024. The proposed corrections pertain solely to the "Gabbro Soils" and "Line and Cover 3" supplemental charges for agricultural metered irrigation (AMI) and dual plumbed residential connections. No other FCCs are affected by the proposed corrections.
