Forebay Dam Modification Project

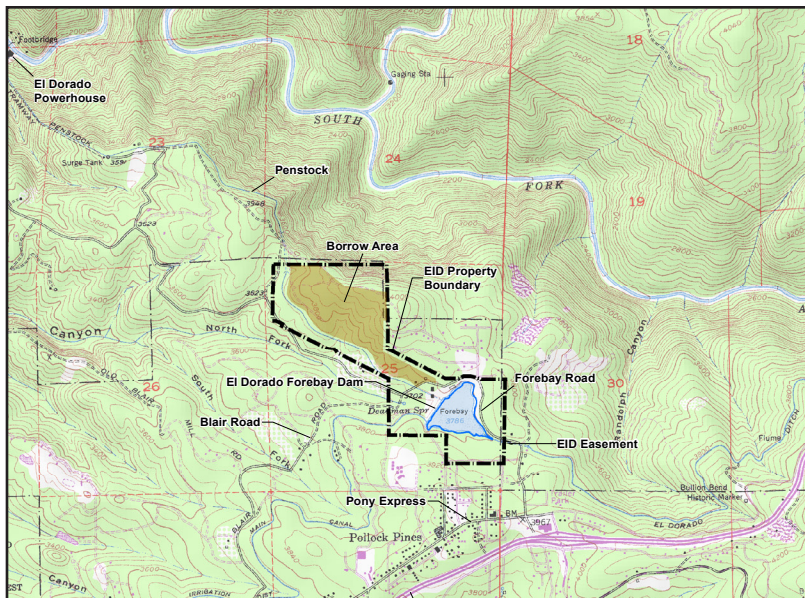
