PLANNED SEWER PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION ON OAKMONT LANE, LAKEVIEW DRIVE, AND SOUTH SHINGLE ROAD BEGINS IN JUNE

Mother Lode Force Main Phase 2C – Public Meeting Wednesday, March 20

Placerville, Calif. — El Dorado Irrigation District is continuing the sewer pipeline construction project of the Mother Lode Force Main, with construction anticipated to begin in June 2013 and complete by August 2013. The construction area will be along Oakmont Lane, Lakeview Drive, and a small portion of South Shingle Road (see attached map). In accordance with the County's encroachment permit, it is anticipated that construction will occur between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Sewer services will not be affected during construction. Traffic control will be implemented to maintain traffic flow.

The project is part the District's ongoing capital improvement plan (CIP) to replace the original sewer pipes for the Mother Lode Force Main.
