

## Ten Ways to Stay Informed and Provide Comment on the El Dorado Forebay Dam Modification Project

- 1. **Attend meetings:** Attend the public scoping meeting on April 1 and register on-site for the E-News at the sign-in desk to receive information via e-mail.
- 2. **Website:** Visit <u>www.eid.org</u> and click on "Forebay Dam Project" for information and project updates.
- 3. **"The Waterfront" Newsletter:** If you are an EID customer, you receive this in the mail with your bimonthly bill, or you may access it from our website. We will be providing regular updates on the project and how to provide comment throughout the process.
- 4. **E-News:** Sign up for the EID's E-News at <a href="www.eid.org">www.eid.org</a> to receive project updates.
- 5. **Comment form:** Through April 11, 2013, you can fill out and submit a comment form to the EID office at 2890 Mosquito Road, Placerville, CA 95667.
- 6. **Local newspapers:** Information regarding meetings and opportunities to provide comment will be posted in The Mountain Democrat and The Sacramento Bee.
- 7. **Phone:** Call the office at (530) 642-4168 for information, to get on the mailing list or to speak to a project representative.
- 8. Mail: Sign up to receive project updates by mail by calling (530) 642-4168

- 10. **On-site:** Note that during the environmental review process, project information will be posted at the Forebay Dam project site.
