RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EL DORADO IRRIGATION DISTRICT IN RECOGITION OF EXEMPLARY SERVICE BY BILL GEORGE

WHEREAS, Bill George has provided distinguished service to El Dorado Irrigation District and its customers as a member of its Board of Directors since 2003; and

WHEREAS, Director George's service has included three terms as Vice-President of the EID Board of Directors, in 2006, 2011, and 2014, and four terms as President, in 2007, 2012, 2015, and 2016; and

WHEREAS, as Board President, Director George oversaw the completion of such lasting accomplishments as the Sly Park Recreation Area Master Plan, the placement of EID's workers' compensation insurance policy with a different, lower-cost insurer, the emergency repair of landslides threatening the El Dorado Powerhouse, the restoration of Esmeralda Creek and replacement of water diversion facilities, the improvement of Rock Crusher Road to improve access and significantly reduce the expense of Project 184 flume repairs, the consolidation of EID elections with statewide elections, EID's first successful sale of surplus water supplies, the conversion of \$111 million of variable-rate debt to \$85 million of fixed-rate debt, and the long-term addition of 17,000 acre-feet per year to EID's portfolio of available water supplies; and

WHEREAS, while serving on the EID Board of Directors, Director George has been a tireless advocate for EID at the regional level, having been a Director of the Sacramento-area Regional Water Authority since 2007 and completed terms as Executive Committee member, Vice-Chair, and Chair of that organization, and having also been a Director of the Mountain Counties Water Resources Association since 2009 and served one year as its Treasurer, two years as its Vice-President, and three years as its President; and

WHEREAS, Director George has also steadfastly represented EID's interests in the Association of California Water Agencies, beginning with his 2005 election to the ACWA Region 3 Board and continuing thereafter with elections to the Vice-Chair and Chair of that Board, a position on the ACWA statewide Board of Directors since 2013, and active participation in the ACWA Joint Powers Insurance Authority, the Finance, Business Development, Water Management and Energy committees, and ACWA's Dues and Sustainable Groundwater Management task forces; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service on the EID Board of Directors, Bill George has served as a Director of the El Dorado Water and Power Authority, an alternate Director of the El Dorado County

Water Agency, a member of the El Dorado County Airport Commission and Placerville Airport Advisory Committee, and a member of numerous community organizations, including the Taxpayers Association of El Dorado County and El Dorado County Citizens for Water; and

WHEREAS, prior to his EID service, Director George was a 31-year information technology professional for IBM, and skillfully applied his professional experience to his EID service; and

WHEREAS, Director George is an avid pilot and certified flight instructor who flew volunteer missions for many years for Angel Flight, transporting injured and sick patients, as well as flying search and rescue missions for the Sheriff's Air Squadron; and

WHEREAS, in his 81st year, Director George remains an active retiree, a confirmed extrovert, and a super, fantastic, incredible, preternatural individual who is still getting better;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the El Dorado Irrigation District (Board) as follows:

- A. The Board gratefully acknowledges Bill George's thirteen years of outstanding service to El Dorado Irrigation District and the public it serves.
- B. The Board commends Bill George for his commitment to advocating EID's interests at the regional and state levels, as well.
- C. The Board finds and declares that in all of his actions and accomplishments, Bill George has shown himself to be a tireless public servant who exemplifies the very finest attributes of citizenship and character.
